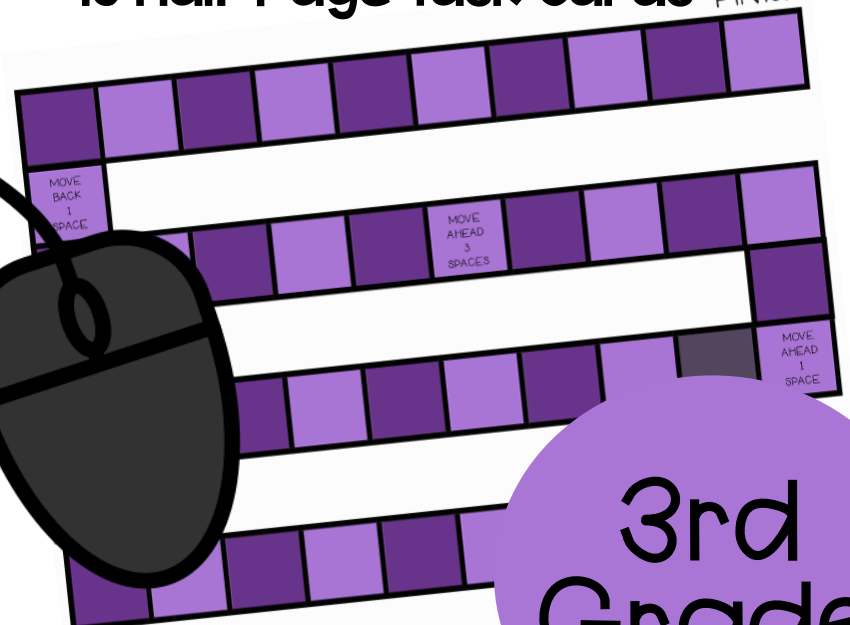

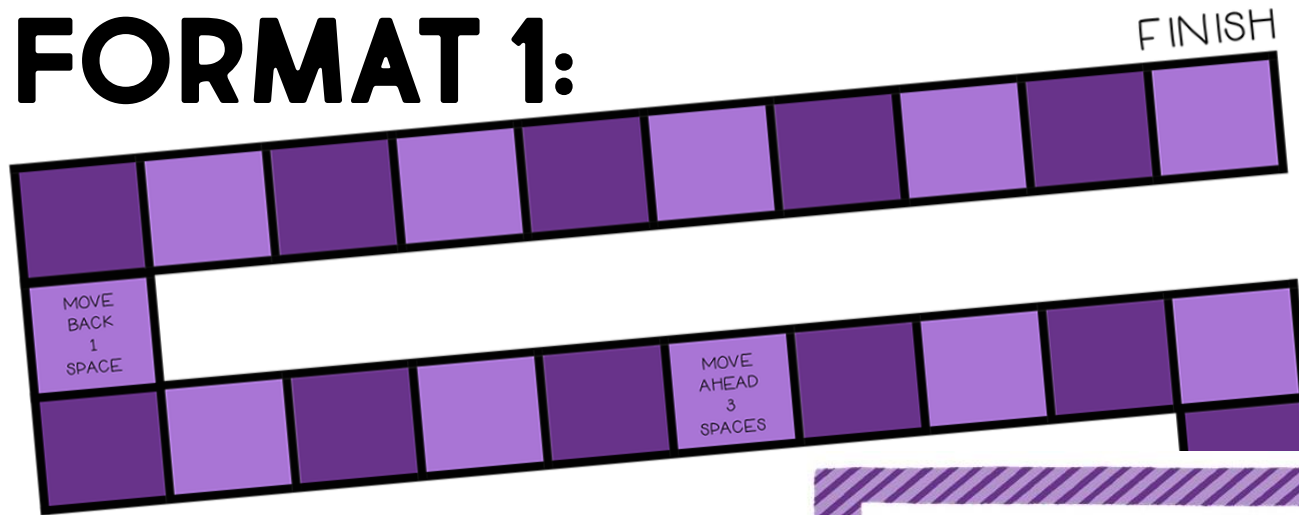

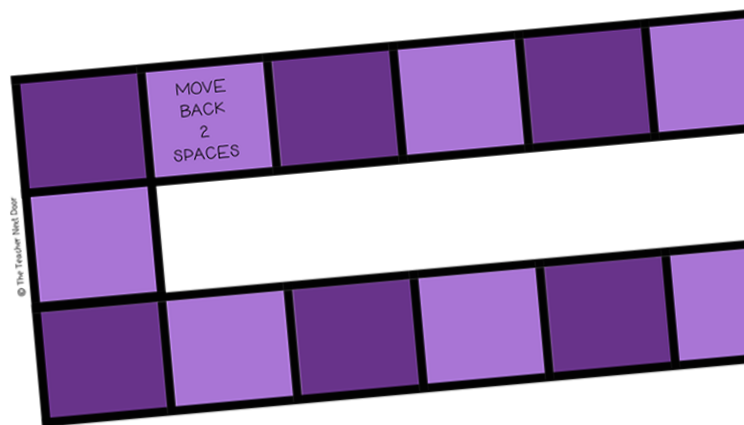

### Compare and Contrast: Planets

#### Jupiter

Jupiter is the fifth planet from the sun. It is also the largest planet and could fit 1,300 Earths inside of it! Jupiter is called a gas giant because it is mostly made out of gas. Jupiter has a famous area called the Great Red Spot. The Great Red Spot is a storm which has been swirling for about 400 years! Jupiter has lots of moons. As of 2018, scientists have found 69 moons around Jupiter! Jupiter also has rings, but they are hard to see.

#### Saturn

Saturn is the sixth planet from the sun. It is the second largest planet after Jupiter. Saturn is one of the outer planets (with Jupiter, Uranus, Neptune) and is a gas giant. It is famous for its rings. Gas giants are made of hydrogen and helium. As of 2018, scientists have found 82 moons around Saturn!
