Yes = 3 points Sometimes = 2 points Never = 1 point

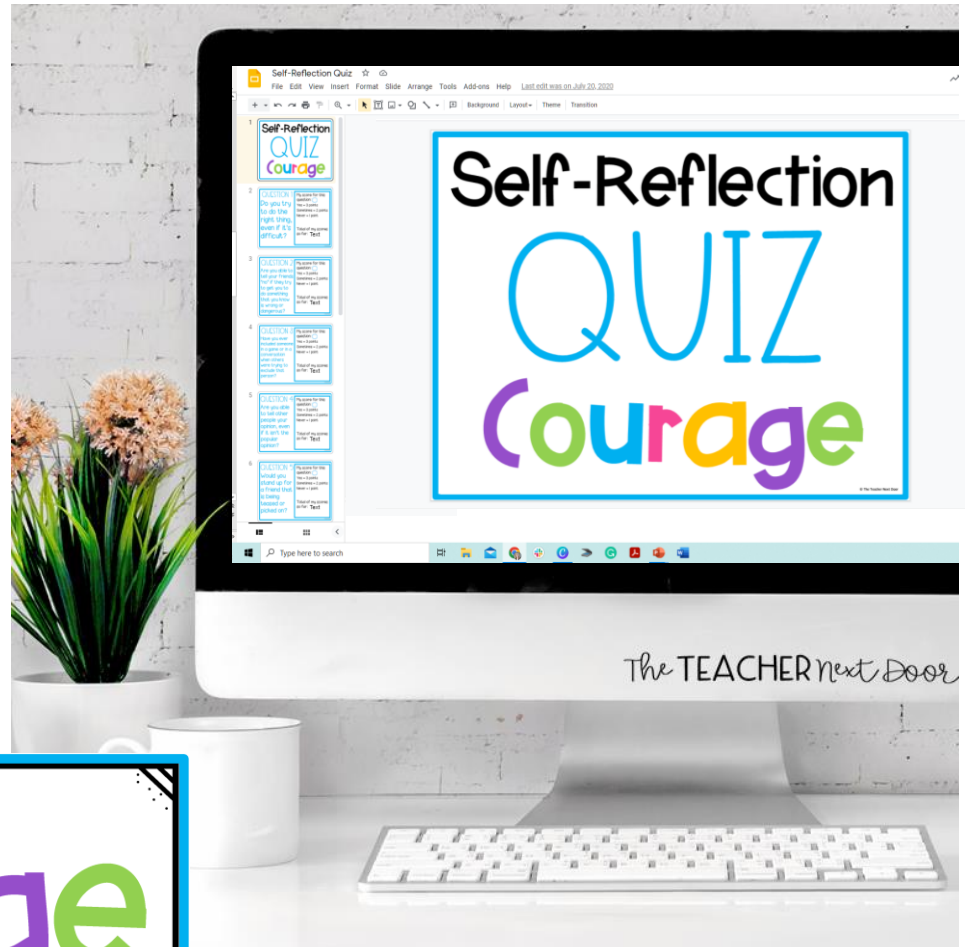
1. Do you try to do the right thing, even if it's difficult?

William noticed two older boys playing keep away with a first grader's backpack. He walked away as fast as he could.

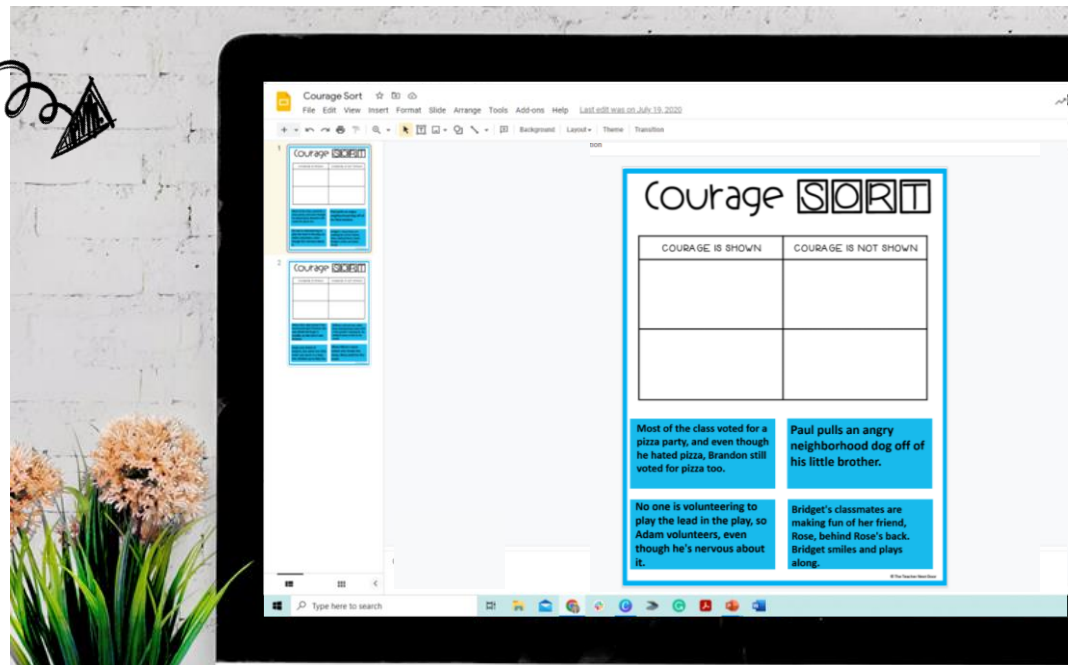
Kayla was afraid of heights, but when her little sister was stuck in a tree, she climbed up to help her.

Read each rectangle and decide whether or not the person showed courage. Then cut, sort, and glue each rectangle under the correct title above.

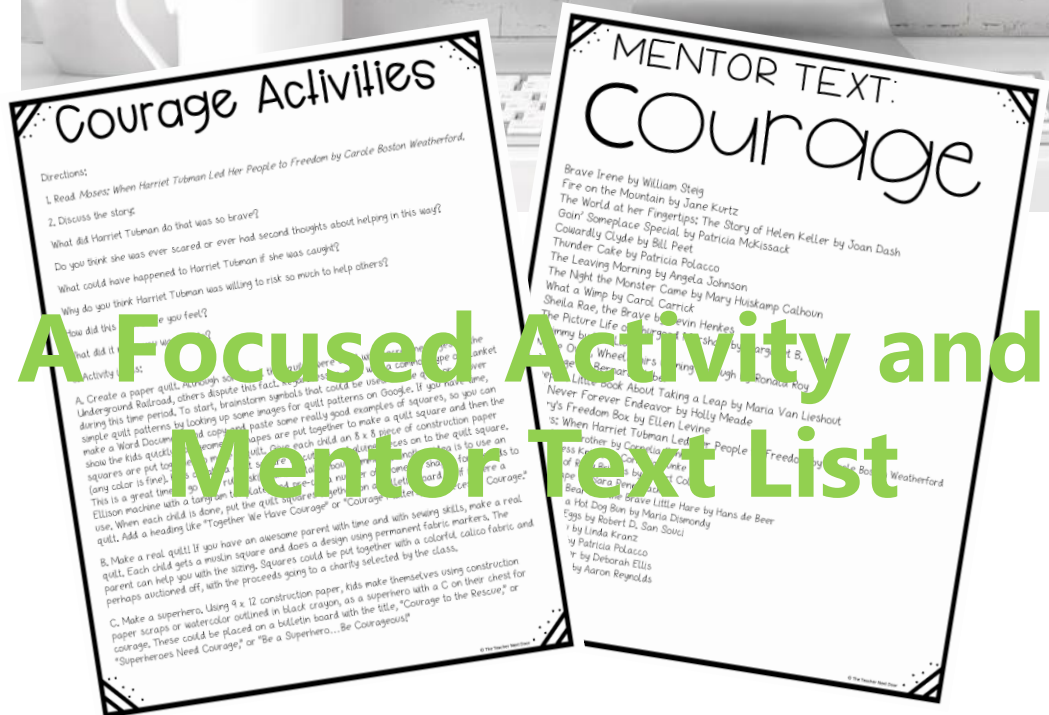

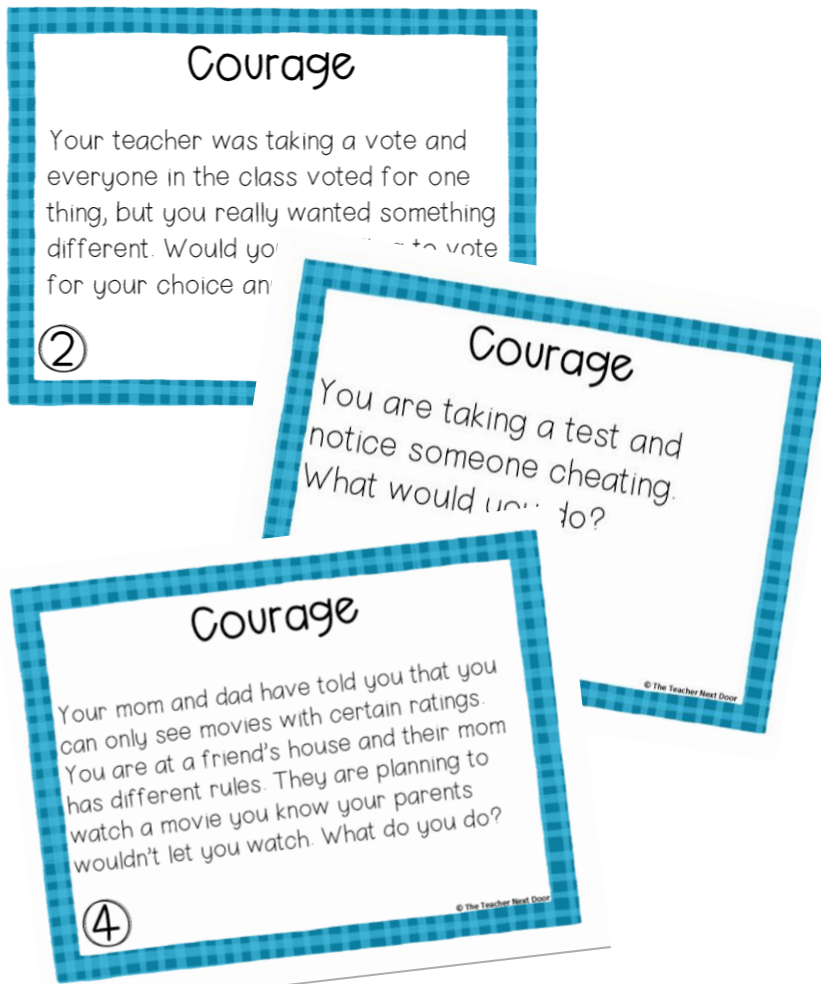
