▶ **THE MOON**

Scientists believe that the Moon was created 4.5 billion years ago when a large object hit the Earth and caused large rocks to break out of the Earth. These rocks orbited the Earth and eventually cooled down, melted together and became the Moon. For another 500 million years, the Moon was hit by pieces of space rock that created numerous craters.

The Earth was also hit by space rocks but over time, the damage is less noticeable due to the erosion from wind and rain. Since the Moon has no atmosphere, the craters are unchanged.

A hurricane is a huge storm! It can be as large as 600 miles across and have strong spiraling winds at speeds of 75 to 200 mph. Hurricanes gather energy from the evaporation of warm ocean water. That's why most hurricanes form near the equator, where the sun's direct rays make water evaporate more quickly. As water vapor rises, strong winds carry it upward and cause it to start circling. A hurricane usually lasts for over a week, moving 10-20 miles per hour when it's over the open ocean and slows down as it hits land.
