**CONCLUSION PARAGRAPH OPINION WRITING**

**THE CONCLUSION: REASONS**

In the conclusion paragraph, after the opinion sentence, the writer reminds the reader of the three big reasons.

There are two ways to write these reasons:

- In one sentence (the reasons are combined)
- In three brief sentences (with transition words)

**CONCLUSION PARAGRAPH EXAMPLE**

Opinion: I believe that having a pet beagle is a good idea for anyone who is responsible.

Reasons: 1. Having a pet beagle can boost your mood. 2. Having a pet beagle can help you take care of a responsibility. 3. Having a pet beagle can help you be more responsible.

Conclusion Sentence: Therefore, having a pet beagle is a good idea for anyone who is responsible.

**CONCLUSION PARAGRAPH: WHAT IS A CALL TO ACTION?**

The very last sentence of a conclusion paragraph can be written in two ways. You can write a final thought or a call to action. A call to action asks readers to think about something or to do something about the issue in the essay.

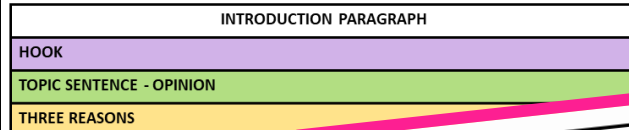
