**Women's History: Shades of Meaning**

Martha Graham was born on May 11, 1894, in Allegheny County, Pennsylvania. Her dancing career began in 1916 at Denishawn, the school and dance company founded in Los Angeles by Ruth St. Denis and Ted Shawn. There she learned a variety of world dances including folk, classical, experimental, Asian, and American Indian. In 1923, she left Denishawn to be a featured dancer in the Greenwich Village Follies Revue, where she remained for two years and to teach at the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, New York. Martha continued to teach dance and to choreograph dances in her **unique** style, called modern dance. In her life time, she created more than 180 works, from solos to large-scale pieces, in most of which she herself danced.
